Participating groups may have between 2 and 6 members. All groups will be provided with the wood, hardware and oars needed. On Sunday June 20, we'll use the old Lewes Boat Ramp in the Canalfront Park to launch your boat! The fee for the program is \$750 and includes materials, lunch on Saturday and Sunday and a program t-shirt.

Don't have boat building or advanced carpentry skills? Not a problem; our team of dedicated volunteers will help show you the ropes and direct you. At the end of the weekend you'll have a beautiful 12-foot Bevin Skiff to take home with you in addition to the memories of time well spent with family and friends.
