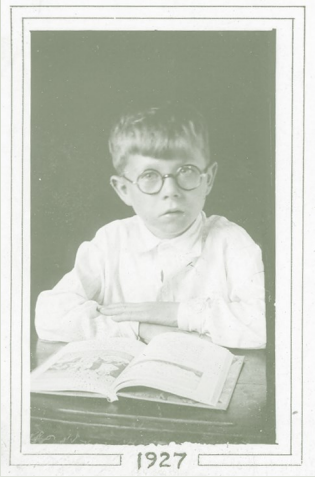


# Children's Historic Adventures in Reading

- Children 12 years of age and younger - no cost

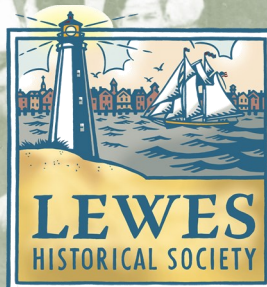
